Dear Councillor,

I wrote to you recently to update you about our overhead line refurbishment work between Landulph and Exeter.

I'd like to thank you for being so forthcoming with useful information and advice as we carried out the first phase of works. As a representative of your local area, your insight is valuable in ensuring the project runs smoothly.

I want to let you know about the upcoming night-closure of a small section of the M5 motorway.

We'll carry out scaffolding work on the stretch of line which crosses the M5 between junctions 28 and 30 from 10pm Sunday 30 July and 6am Monday 31 July. This means the M5 will close between those junctions. A diversion route will be in place. Details can be found on the project Google Map [here](#). We'll continue the following evening if further work is needed during the same hours.

We'll erect scaffolding through the night to minimise disruption to residents and commuters. We'll continue working on that stretch of line while the scaffolding is in place.
